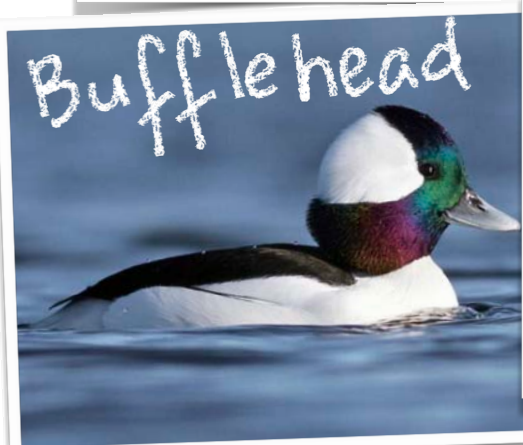




Como Lake Birds in the Winter

Did you know that ducks can be dabblers or divers?

Dabbling ducks go "bottoms up" when they eat. Most often they stay in shallow water around the edges of wetlands. Mallards are dabblers.

Diving ducks dive below the water's surface when they eat. They prefer deeper water in the middle of wetlands. Grebes and mergansers are divers.
